



## Embassy of India Kuwait

### Advisory for Indian nationals newly arriving in Kuwait

- Indian nationals arriving on Employment/Work Visa should get Residency Permit stamped through their Employer/Sponsor within 60 days of their date of arrival in Kuwait. (If not, Penalty fee of KWD 2/- per day is charged by Kuwait Government authorities.)
- Civil ID should be applied for and prescribed payment should be made within 60 days of your date of arrival in Kuwait. (If not, Penalty fee of KWD 20/- is charged by Kuwait Government authorities.)
- Indian nationals arriving on Tourist Visa should exit Kuwait before the date of expiry of Visa period. (In case of overstay, Penalty fee of KWD 2/- per day is charged by Kuwait Government authorities. They might also face Deportation and re-entry ban.)
- Indian nationals arriving on Family Visa should exit Kuwait before the date of expiry of Visa period. (In case of overstay, Penalty fee of KWD 10/- per day is charged by Kuwait Government authorities. They might also face Deportation and re-entry ban.)
