

UPDATE ON THE RECENT TRAVEL ADVISORY RELATED TO CORONAVIRUS ISSUED
BY STATE OF KUWAIT

Members of the Indian Community in Kuwait would be aware that Directorate General of Civil Aviation, State of Kuwait, vide its circular notification dated 03 March 2020, has made it mandatory for all passengers travelling to Kuwait from any one of the 10 countries (including India) to produce medical certificates, proving coronavirus-free status, prior to embarkation with effect from the 8th of March 2020. These certificates have to be obtained from medical centres approved by resident Embassies of State of Kuwait in these countries.

In this regard, to address the genuine concerns of members of the Community and other passengers travelling from India to Kuwait, clarifications regarding the approved medical centres, underlying procedures and other relevant aspects are being ascertained by the Embassy of India from the concerned authorities of the State of Kuwait.
