**Vidyanjali Initiative**

Vidyanjali is an online portal launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 7th September 2021, with the aim of strengthening the infrastructure, facilities and improving the quality of education in government and government aided schools by splicing voluntary contribution and support from citizens, NRIs, persons of Indian origin, companies, civil societies etc.

2. Volunteer can contribute through Vidyanjali portal either by providing (i) services or (ii) assets/ materials/equipment

3. Under 'services' a volunteer can provide subject assistance, assistance for teaching art & craft, yoga, vocational skills etc, or sponsorship of trained counselors, special educators etc.

4. 'Assets/material/equipment' **cannot** be in the form of monetary support. It can include basic infrastructure, classroom support materials, digital infrastructure, sports equipment, learning equipment, office stationery/ furniture etc.

5. Volunteers interested in the programme can easily connect with the schools of their choice by following simple steps:

- Login the portal (<https://vidyanjali.education.gov.in/en>) as individual volunteer/organization/company/PSU/NRI
- Select the school for contribution
- Select the type of contribution
- Fill the required details
- Provide the required service/assets/material/equipment
